CAEL BAND DESCRIPTORS

80-90	Expert User: Demonstrates a high level of competence in using English in academic settings. Language is accurate and flexible.
70	Adept User: Demonstrates competence in using English in academic settings. Language is accurate but minor limitations are evident in flexibility.
60	Competent User: Demonstrates competence in using English in academic settings, but some limitations are evident in both accuracy and flexibility.
50	Competent but Limited User: Demonstrates uneven competence in using English in academic settings. Limitations are evident in accuracy; there is little evidence of flexibility.
40	Marginally Competent User: Demonstrates some ability to comprehend and articulate complex ideas and extended arguments typical of academic settings, but major limitations are evident in accuracy.
30	Limited User: Demonstrates an ability to comprehend main idea, but unable to identify specific details. Has control of simple sentence structures and attempts to produce complex structures, usually unsuccessfully.
20	Very Limited User: Demonstrates a limited ability to comprehend main idea and express simple ideas in academic settings. Has uneven control of even simple sentence structures.
10	Non User: Ability to communicate ideas is limited to non-academic settings

About the CAEL Assessment Official Score Report

The CAEL Assessment Official Score Report provides information for both test takers and receiving institutions. The Score Report has two main functions:

- It provides an overall band score that is used by receiving institutions for the purposes of admission and/or placement in a program of study.
- It gives test takers **diagnostic feedback** on their ability to use English for academic purposes.

Test Identification

The test location and test date are provided for easy reference.

Test Result

Each test taker receives an overall band score, which ranges from level 10 (non-user) to level 90 (expert user). The overall band score is a weighted average of the four sub-test results. This overall band score is used by receiving institutions to make decisions about admission and/or placement in a program of study.

Sub-test Result

The Score Report includes a band score for each of the four sub-tests – reading, listening, writing and speaking, and may be used for diagnostic purposes.
